Kurtis R. Hort, M.D., with Orthopaedic Associates of St Augustine, recently gave a lecture as part of an orthopaedic medical conference. The course, Lower Extremities – Orthopedic Challenges and Solutions, was held at the Miami Beach Resort & Spa. Dr Hort spoke about calcaneal fractures in a lecture titled "What's New with Calcaneal Fractures?" A calcaneal fracture is a fracture of the calcaneus or the heel bone, the largest bone of the human foot. In his talk, he addressed various procedures for stabilizing this type of fracture along with their advantages and disadvantages. Dr Hort is Board Certified by the American Board of Orthopedic Surgery and fellowship trained in lower extremity reconstruction and complex foot and ankle surgery. He is also an active member of the American Orthopaedic Foot and Ankle Society.
